OVERVIEW OF AGRICULTURAL SECTOR AND FOOD INDUSTRY

Favourable climatic conditions are suitable for growing fruit and vegetables, especially vines. Apples, sour cherries and plums are the most common fruit cultures, and among vegetables is potato. The city area is the only vineyard in the RS. It is known for production of honey, tobacco, medicinal and aromatic herbs, and quality varieties of figs.

Typical traditional products for Trebinje are wine and honey. The City of Trebinje possesses unpolluted soil, satisfactory water quality, what represents a condition for production of eco-friendly food (cheese, smoked ham, Poljak bean, early vegetables)

FAVOURABLE CLIMATIC CONDITIONS

- Agricultural cooperative "Petrovo polje", its main activity is viticulture, as well as production of all traditional and typical products on the organic base.
- Beekeepers cooperative "Žalfija", covers region of East Herzegovina. Its aim is development of beekeeping sector by encouraging the production, placement and sell of bee products from this area.

REGISTERED ASSOCIATIONS

- Association of wingrowers and wineproducers "Vinos" in the area of Herzegovina has the aim to create a worldwide recognizable brand, control the grape origin and thus geographically protect wines produced in these areas. The aim of Trebinje Businessmen Association is faster and more transparent resolving of the problems arising in economic processes.

FAVOURABLE BUSINESS ENVIRONMENT

SUCCESSFUL STORY



- Popovo polje, Joint-stock Company, established in 1977, is dealing with fruit production.
- Production is based on the use of modern technologies, and the team of agronomists is in charge for products quality following the world standards.
- Orchards are located in the fertile field of Popovo polje, located between Trebinje and Ljubinje.
- Apples, sweet cherries and grapes are produced on the plantation, and the products are placed on the local and foreign market.
- Modern packing department includes complete process from washing to classification by size, weight and quality.
- The fact that apples produced in Popovo polje are already recognizable brand on the many European markets is shown through the data that most of this year growth, over 1000 tons, will be exported to the European Union.
- The current 75 ha planted by apples is planned to be expanded to 250 or 300 ha until 2020.
