OVERVIEW OF AGRICULTURAL SECTOR AND FOOD INDUSTRY

Favourable climatic conditions are suitable for growing fruit and vegetables, especially vines. Apples, sour cherries and plums area the most common fruit cultures, and among vegetables is potato. The city area is the only vineyard in the RS. It is know for production of honey, tobacco, medicinal and aromatic herbs, and quality varieties of figs.

Typical traditional products for Trebinje are wine and honey. The City of Trebinje possesses unpolluted soil, satisfactory water quality, what represents a condition for production of eco-friendly food (cheese, smoked ham, Poljak bean, early vegetables).

- Cattle breeding, mini farms and dairy farm
- Collecting, purchasing and processing of medicinal herbs
- Production of edible fish
- Production of indigenous vegetable species from Hezegovina (the "Poljak" bean) – organic production

SUCCESSFUL STORY



- Established in 1977, Popovo polje company operated until the last war (1991-1995) when there was the biological destruction of the raised perennial plantations. Newly established company, Popovo polje, joint-stock company Trebinje is a new land concessionaire in Popovo polje, which is engaged in fruit and vineyard production.
- Production is based on the use of modern technologies, and the team of agronomists is in charge for products quality following the world standards.
- Orchards are located in the fertile field of Popovo polje, located between Trebinje and Ljubinje.
- Apples, pears, sweet cherries and grapes (wine and table varieties) are grown on the plantation, and the products are placed on the local and foreign market.
- Modern packing machine includes a complete washing process, classification by size, weight and quality.
- The fact that apples from Popovo polje have already become a recognizable brand on European market is evidenced by the data that the most of this year's growth, over 1000 tons, will be exported to the European Union.
- It is planned to expand orchards under apples and pears in the coming period
